**GAO adopts Chronicle Graphics' OnePager software**

*Government Accountability Office aims to increase project oversight by simplifying schedule graphics*

**CENTENNIAL, COLO – June 18, 2009** – The United States Government Accountability Office (GAO) has adopted Chronicle Graphics' OnePager Pro and OnePager Express software to create more visibility into government spending. OnePager Pro and Express import schedule data from Microsoft Office Project and Excel, respectively, to create full-color project snapshots. Other government agencies, including those at the federal, state, and local levels, have begun to follow the GAO's lead as they, too, try to create more visibility into how taxpayer dollars are being spent.
